

Biography of Dr. Bobby White

Dr. Bobby White was born in Nassawadox, Virginia and grew up in the town of Accomack on the Eastern Shore of Virginia. After graduating high school, he moved to Virginia Beach where he decided to plant roots, beginning a career and starting a family. In 1998, he dedicated his life to the Lord and joined Closer Walk Christian Fellowship, which transitioned into Calvary Revival Church Chesapeake.

Dedicating his life to the Lord stirred a desire to serve God authentically and with passion. Because of this, Dr. White started a Hip Hop ministry, which incorporated the dancing, rapping and music that initially drew him to the church. Dr. White became involved with the local community and took on the challenge of organizing events that would impact youth naturally and spiritually. His time as youth pastor eventually led him to be ordained to the office of Pastor in 2008.

He offers counsel and training on how to serve the local church and its' leadership, which he has done successfully for over 15 years.
